Visit Yorkshire Sculpture Park (free for under-25s!)

Make a map of your neighbourhood from memory

Design your dream playground

Ask a grown-up about their favourite summer memory - and share yours too!

Paint with natural things (leaves, twigs, etc.)

Set up a teddy bear's picnic

Collect leaves and make leaf rubbings

Make a time capsule

Do a "yes day" (within reason!)

Write a story or comic strip

Go on a bug hunt in your garden or a local green space

Visit the National Coal Mining Museum's summer activities

Visit Canshon Hall Park & Gardens (free to roam!)

Host a garden sports day

Spot wildlife at RSPB Dearne Valley or Old Moor

Make sock puppets and put on a show

Draw your favourite place

Explore the woods at Bretton Country Park

Sing a silly song and record it
