

A development programme empowering women to grow, lead and create impact - in their businesses, and in their personal and professional lives.

#WECAN – Impact and Growth builds on the success of the 2021–2025 #WECAN project, offering a targeted programme to help businesses strengthen, upskill, and empower women across their organisation.

The programme is also relevant for women setting up or growing their own businesses, including those who may not yet see themselves as leaders, supporting them to build confidence, decision making capability, emotional intelligence, and personal impact.

Central to the programme is Women Leading With Impact, a 12 month development series enriched by mentoring, peer learning, and a structured community of practice. Participants gain practical tools, increased confidence, and measurable insights into their strengths through an Emotional Intelligence (EQ) diagnostic, helping them apply learning immediately within their organisations, roles, or businesses.

Participants also benefit from events, roundtables, and networking opportunities that bring together a powerful community of women at all stages of their journey, creating a vibrant environment for shared learning and growth. Participants will be offered a complimentary place to invite a male ally, recognising that their voices are essential to the conversation on gender equity and their influence is vital in driving meaningful, lasting change.

What the programme includes

- Women Leading With Impact – 12 month leadership workshop series
- Business Mentoring
- Peer to Peer Learning
- Events & Roundtables
- Women's Community of Practice

Workshops cover three core themes:

Leading self

Leading others

Leading for impact and influence
